Game Play Joey Scouts stand in a circle; Leader throws a balloon up in the air and calls a Joey Scouts

name. He/she must run into the centre, hit the balloon and call someone else's name.

Continue until all have had a turn.

Game Potato Relay

Game Play In teams. Relay race with sticks (newspaper rolls) and odd shaped potatoes. Joey Scouts

roll potato to end, round chair, and back to team and pass stick to next in line. Make sure

both potatoes are oddly shaped!

Game Celebrity Heads Activity

Equipment Peak Caps

Labels with various names - Suggestion characters include: Pluto (Dog), Sylvester (Cat),

Tweetie (Bird), Mickey Mouse (Mouse), Tigger (Tiger), Poo Bear (Bear) etc.

Double sided tape – stick labels to hats

Chairs for the three 'celebritys's'

Game Play Select up to three Joey Scouts to be the contestants – they have to guess what name is on

the head band they are wearing. Contestants ask questions in order to determine who they

are. The remaining Joey Scouts respond to the questions – yes, no.

Game Find A Group

Equipment Nil

Game Play Leader calls out a number and Joey Scouts have to form groups of that number.

Variation: This may also be played as shapes.




Closing PARADE
