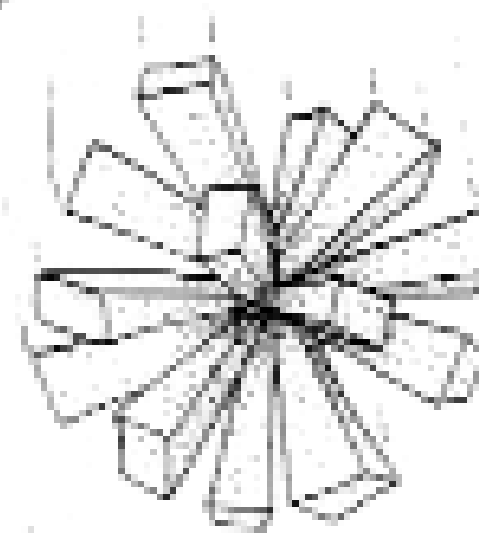
Coming In Activity: Foam Sponge Ball

Equipment:

3 Large sponges (use different coloured sponges)
1 Plastic cable tie or elastic band
Scissors

Method:

1. Cut each sponge into thirds lengthwise.
2. Stack the cut sponges on top of each other in three rows of three.
3. Grab the stack of sponges in the centre and twist the stack once.
4. Secure a plastic cable tie around the centre of the twisted stack, pulling it as tight as possible.
5. Trim the plastic cable tie down as close to the eye as possible.



These you can use for our wet games instead of water balloons.

Game: Charlie over the water

Equipment: Nil.

Method: Joey Scouts form a circle with “Charlie” in the middle. Joey Scouts hold hands and sing the song. At the end of the song the Joey Scouts drop hands and Charlie tries to catch someone. That Joey Scout becomes Charlie and the game is restarted.

**Charlie over the water,
Charlie over the sea
Charlie caught a fish,
But he can't catch me.**

These games are in recognition of World Day of Post which is the 9th October 2011.

Game: LAW Letters

Equipment: 8 Envelops (or two sets in different colours if required) with the one word from the law on the back of each (A Joey Scout Cares A Joey Scout Shares) and addressed to each JS on the front, and a large box.

Method: Collect the letters from the postal box (a large box painted up to look like a postal box) and sort them (issue to each JS), ask Joeys to use the clues on the back of the envelopes to make the JS Law.

Game: Post the Parcel

Equipment: A large box and our sponge balls.

Method: Cover or paint a large box to look like a post box. Stabilize the box with a weight in the bottom and make the top open. If it's hot enough to be playing in water put the sponge balls in a bucket of water and the JS take turns posting the letters (sponge balls), by throwing them into the post office box.

Game: Post the Letter

Equipment: Envelop shapes are cut out of tissue or crepe paper. JS can decorate with stamps and names and addresses. Folded newspaper sheet each.

Method: Joey Scouts line their letters up side by side and use the paper to create a breeze to move their letters towards the post box.

Game: Ice Hockey

Equipment: Frozen puck (made from freezing water in a margarine container, plastic tarp and newspaper bats (rolled up newspapers secured with electrical tape/masking tape makes for a longer lasting bat).

Method: Place the tarp on the floor, in the middle of the tarp place your ice puck and two newspaper bats. Divide JS in half and line up on either side of the tarp, number them off. Leader calls a number the two JS with that number go onto the mat, pick up a bat and try to get the puck off their designated end of the tarp.

Game: Catch the sponge

Equipment: Sponges and plenty of water.

Method: Joey Scouts throw and catch sponges with a partner.

Game: Pass the sponge

Equipment: Sponges filled with water.

Method: JSs stand in a line and pass sponges over their heads to the next person. The Joey Scout at the front reloads the sponge with water and goes to the end of the line with the sponge to repeat.

Game: What's the time Mr. Cloud?

Equipment: Small water pistol filled with water.

Method: Played outside. Played as "What's the time Mr. Wolf" One Joey is Mr. Cloud holding the water pistol. Others Joeys following ask "What's the time Mr. Cloud?" Mr. Cloud replies "Summer time" or "winter time", etc., and every so often says, "It's rain time". When rain time is said Mr. Cloud tries to wet the other JSs. They restart with a new Mr. Cloud and the game continues.

Game: Ice and Water

Equipment: Nil

Method: Joey Scouts move around until Leader calls Ice or Water. On Ice they must freeze, but when Water is called they must flop to the floor. Anyone who does the wrong action, or moves when supposed to be frozen, is out.

Game: Water Relay (outside game)

Equipment: You will need 1 (foam) cup per player, 1 bucket and 1 saucepan per team.

Method: JSs in two teams, each has a cup with a hole in the bottom. In turn, Joey Scouts must fill the cup with water from the bucket at the front of the team and run to where the saucepan is and tip the water in. They must not block the hole with anything and the team has to try to fill the saucepan with water.
