Approx Time	Activity Description	Equipment Required
5:00	Inspection: Share a different type of weather to the other members of your Six Grand Howl	
5:10	*Twister All spin around counting back from 5. If tagged by 'It', spin 5 times before you can run off again.	Nil
5:20	*Weather Pairs sitting in a long 'ladder' with feet together. Give each pair a different weather themed name eg: thunder, lightning, sun, rain. When Leader calls out the name, that pair run down the middle of the ladder, around the outside and back to their spot;	Nil
5:30	Rain Gauge Cut the top off a plastic bottle. Insert it upside down. Pour and measure water, marking the millilitres on the side with texta.	Plastic bottle, scissors, texta, water, measuring jugs
5:45	Rain Dance Bobs and statues with rain or water themed music.	Music player, music
5:55	NSEW Leader calls instructions to run in various wind directions.	Nil
6:00	AIR EXPERIMENTS (Boomerang Part 10) Bronze – composition of air. Show how oxygen can be used up by lighting a candle and placing it in the middle of a saucer of water. Let the candle burn a little and then place an upturned jar or glass over the top. As the air is used up, the water will be sucked up the sides of the glass to form a seal and the candle will blow out. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LOQObaAo8GM Silver – show how rain is formed by placing an empty cup inside a glass bowl. Pour some hot water into the bowl around the outside of the empty glass. Cover the bowl with cling wrap and place an ice cube in the centre of the cling wrap. The evaporated water will rise up to the top of the plastic wrap, cool down and condense around the ice cube before dripping back down into the empty glass as 'rain'. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FmTh0ECGPCY	Candles, jars, matches, saucers Ice cube, empty glass, hot water, cling wrap, glass bowl
6:15	Ping pong Ball Relay Blow ping pong ball along the floor with a straw.	Straw per cub, ping pong ball per team
6:25	Closing Ceremony Distribute weather chart, to be returned if they'd like to pass their weather badge.
